Since then, the Barberpole Cat Program has been considered consistently successful. The current list of 12 songs was selected in 1987 by a vote of Society members.

The Barber Pole Cat Program was created many years ago and features popular Barbershop songs arranged and voiced so ALL singers can learn and participate.

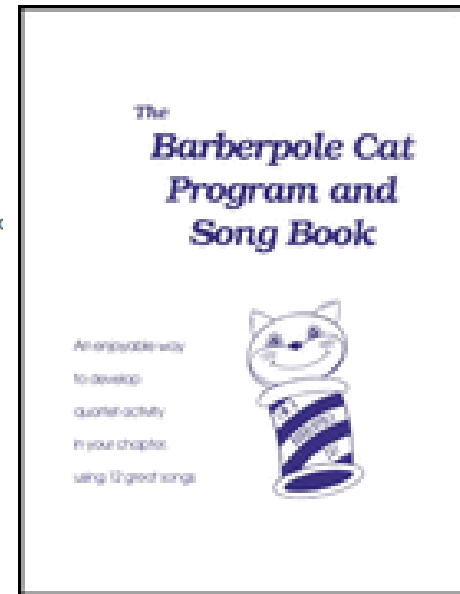
For decades these have been the standard arrangements where singers can meet at conventions and sing together having never met before.
